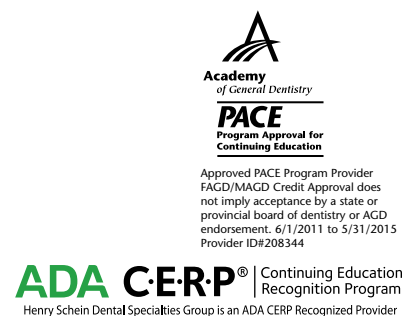
Dr. Christopher Hydo
